ATTENDEE PROFILE & CONFERENCE FOCUS

This year, ASCUE will be reaching out to its member institutions' CIOs, CTOs, and instructional technologists as well as provosts, academic deans, and influential faculty members to take part in the conference.

- **Empathy** how is care/concern informing our decision making? How can we use technology to better care for our students? To better improve the learning experience? The work experience?
- **Equity** How is our IT-related decision making impacting our students (or faculty/staff/etc.)? For example, is a particular policy discriminatory? Is it causing undue burden? Have we assessed the impact of a particular implementation/lesson plan/etc.
- Intentionality What are the problems (learning/infrastructure, etc.) that we are trying to solve? For example, in the classroom, am I using a particular technology because it's cool or because it's helping students engage/achieve a learning outcome? How am I measuring its success? How am I accounting for the IT-related issues? What kind of support and scaffolding would I need to make this project go off without a hitch? For IT leadership what is the experience of our systems and how can we plan (disaster recovery, updates, etc.) for improvements to have a smaller impact on high-traffic performance? How can we leverage our funding while still providing a good educational experience (through partnerships like HESS, etc.)


